#### From East

- Take Route 33 West to Route 571 West.
- Turn right onto Route 1 North.
- Continue on Route 1 North for 3 miles to the College Road West Exit.
- Go through the traffic light.
- The hotel will be on the left.

#### From West

- Take Route 1 North to I-95 North into New Jersey.
- The road turns into I-295 South.
- Take I-295 South to Exit 67 (Route 1 North).
- Continue for approximately 6 miles to the College Road West Exit.
- The hotel will be on the left.

#### From South

- Take Interstate 95 North, which turns into Interstate 295 North.
- Continue on I-295 North to Exit 67 (Route 1 North).
- Take this towards New Brunswick.
- Stay on Route 1 North for approximately 6 miles to the College Road West Exit.
- The hotel will be on the left.

#### **From North**

- Take the New Jersey Turnpike South to Exit 9 to Route 18 North for 1/2 mile.
- Go to Route 1 South for approximately 13 miles to the College Road West Exit.
- Go through the traffic light.
- The hotel will be on the left.
