# Together We Have No Limits!

The Arc of New Jersey is the state's largest organization devoted to advocating for and supporting people with intellectual and developmental disabilities and their families.

Each year, The Arc of New Jersey hosts a Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month outreach event at The Statehouse in Trenton. The theme of this year's event and design contest is "**Together We Have No Limits**". Students in grades 3 - 12 are invited to design a bulletin board, poster, and/or video that incorporates the theme of this year's campaign.

Because awareness, acceptance, and inclusion matter... Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month is a perfect opportunity to educate students about the **spectrum of ability**. For example, some disabilities are visible (a person who uses a wheelchair or crutches to ambulate), while other disabilities may not be easily recognized or seen by the eye (cognitive impairments that affect the way a person speaks, learns, or interacts with others).

Our hope is that you take the theme and truly run with it! Get creative and develop a bulletin board design, poster, or video that is unique to your school and your students' understanding of the belief that awareness, acceptance, and inclusion matter. Winning submissions will demonstrate an understanding of the diversity of disability and the need for inclusion, support, and acceptance in school and beyond.

### Wondering how your school can get involved? It's easy! Pick your medium:

1. Work with your class to develop a creative, eye-catching and colorful **bulletin board** or **poster** that incorporates the theme of this year's campaign. Once you and your class have finalized your design, snap a photo and e-mail it, along with the completed entry form and photo release, to <u>DisabilityAwarenessNJ@ArcNJ.org</u>

2. Create a **video** that relates to the contest theme and illustrates why you believe awareness of developmental disabilities matters. E-mail your video, along with the completed entry form and photo release, to **DisabilityAwarenessNJ@ArcNJ.org** 

The photos you submit can be any size- the bigger, the better!

Please be sure to include a copy of the completed Official Entry Form and signed Photo Release with your submission (only if students appear in the photos or video).

#### Let's talk PRIZES!

All classes and school clubs are encouraged to participate. Sorry, but individual submissions will not be considered. Classes who receive 1st place will be awarded a \$100 gift card, classes who receive 2nd place will be awarded a \$50 gift card, and classes who receive 3rd place will be awarded a \$25 gift card. There will be a total of three winning submissions chosen from each category: Elementary level (3 - 5th grades), Middle School level (6 - 8th grades), and High School (9 - 12th grades).

#### **Contest Timeline**

All submissions are due no later than February 1, 2018. Winning classes will be notified by February 12, 2018. Winning submissions will be on display at Goldfinch Square in The Statehouse in Trenton from March 5 - 9, 2018. Winning classes will be invited to attend our Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month Outreach Event at the Statehouse on Monday, March 5, 2018.
