SSI-Related and Medicaid Only

- <u>Eligibility</u>
 - Aged: \geq 65 years old
 - Blind or Disabled (any age)
- Income
 - ≤945.25 individual; ≤\$1396.35 couple
 - (person or couple living alone or with others in own household)
- <u>Resources</u>
 - <\$2000 for individual; <\$3000 for couples</p>
 - Home and 1 car do not count toward resources



SSI-Related and Medicaid Only: Where do I apply?

- SSI-related Medicaid \rightarrow SSI application = Medicaid application
- Medicaid Only \rightarrow On-Line or with County Welfare Agencies (CWAs)

• Service Package = Plan A (includes Personal Care Assistance)



NJ Care: Aged, Blind, & Disabled

- <u>Eligibility</u>
 - Aged: ≥ 65 years old
 - Blind or Disabled (any age)
- Income
 - ≤\$1215.00 individual, ≤\$1644.00 couple
- <u>Resources</u>
 - <\$4000 for individual; <\$6000 for couples</p>
 - Home and 1 car do not count toward resources

New Jersey Care \rightarrow On-Line or with County Welfare Agencies (CWAs) with paper application

Benefit Package = Plan A

Single Adults and Parents: ACA Expansion or MAGI Medicaid

Ages: 21 - 64 years old*

• No longer eligible upon turning 65

No Disability determination needed:

- $OK \rightarrow disability determination (e.g., SSDI)$
- No longer eligible for MAGI Medicaid once <u>eligible</u> to receive Medicare

Modified Adjusted Gross Income (MAGI)

• Think line #11 on the IRS Form 1040

<u>Income</u> \leq \$1677/month individual (138% FPL)

No resource limit

Single Adults and parents Where do I apply?

- <u>On-line at njfamilycare.org</u>
 - On-line application
 - Download a paper application
 - Most are done at the State level through vendor
- At the County Welfare Agencies (CWAs)
 - Alternative Benefits Plan = ABP

• <u>Eligibility</u>

- Age 16 years to 64 years old
- Working full or part-time with proof of employment
 - Self-employed must have net earning of \$400 and file federal taxes per NJ Medcomm
- Disability Determination
- Total Earned Income Potential
 - If no unearned **income: gross earned income ≤ \$5,729 per month**
 - With unearned income earned income threshold will vary
- <u>Unearned Income Threshold</u> (e.g., alimony, SS Survivors benefits, unemployment, +)
 - Unearned income ≤ \$1215/month for an individual
 - Individual's SSDI is not counted
- <u>Resources</u>
- \$20,000 for individual, \$30,000 for couple
- Does not include: home, 1 car for work/medical transportation, 401K/IRA

DDD Community Care, Supports Program and Supports Plus PDN

Financial Eligibility

- Income \leq \$2742
- Resources \leq \$2000
- Parental SSDI Disregarded

Clinical Eligibility

• An individual must meet the functional criteria of having a developmental disability

<u>Private Duty Nursing:</u> If medically necessary; covered by Medicaid MCO alongside Supports Program



Section 1634 Disabled Adult Child (DAC)

• Eligibility Criteria:

- At least 18 years old
- Disabled or blind prior to 22
- Has been receiving SSI on basis of disability
- Has lost SSI as a result of receipt of SS benefits on parent's record due to retirement, death, or disability
- Resources \leq \$2000 (not including a Special Needs Trust or ABLE)
- RFI = Request for Information from DDD


Where do I apply for CCP and Supports?

Must be DDD eligible: DDD intake including CAT Assessment

• May be eligible under other Medicaid programs (e.g., SSI, ABD)

Eligibility Groups that DO NOT work for DDD



Managed Long Term Services and Supports (MLTSS)

<u>Financial Eligibility</u>

- Income \leq \$2742^{*} for an individual
- Resources < \$2000 for individual
- 5 year look-back: No gifting
- Qualified Income Trust/QIT and Spousal Impoverishment protections

<u>Clinical Eligibility</u>

- Hands-on assistance in 3 ADLs (e.g., bathing, dressing, ambulation) OR if cognitive impairment, supervision/cueing in 3 ADLs
- ≤20 years old More stringent medically necessary criteria (e.g., needs PDN)

Managed Long Term Services and Supports (MLTSS) includes:

- Personal Care Assistance (PCA)(state plan)
- Private Duty Nursing (PDN)
- Respite
- Care management
- Home and vehicle modifications
- Home delivered meals
- Personal emergency response systems
- Mental health and addiction services
- TBI specific community-based services
- Assisted Living Facilities
- Nursing Homes

Medicare Savings Programs

- Qualified Medicare Beneficiary (QMB)
 - Income: ≤100% FPL (\$1215)

QMB "Plus" = individual has full-scope Medicaid

QMB "Only" = ineligible for full scope Medicaid

- <u>Specified Low-Income Medicare Beneficiary Program (SLMB)</u>
 - Income: \leq \$1288/month
- <u>Qualified Individual or QI</u>
 - Income: \leq \$1449/month


