PMR-CP

PMR-CP, broadly speaking, refers to studies exploring potential genetic factors contributing to a cerebral palsy (CP) diagnosis. These studies aim to gather evidence that might contribute to new medical interventions for CP.

Eligibility Criteria

- Adults with CP
- Primary caregivers of adults with CP incapable of consenting to research
- Parents/guardians of minors with CP
- Healthcare providers with experience with CP patients
- Researchers/PIs who have done genetics research involving CP

Purpose

Researchers at Stanford University are conducting a study about how different groups of people perceive the potential benefits and potential harms of emerging precision medicine research on cerebral palsy (PMR-CP). We are also interested in the priorities different groups think should drive PMR-CP in the future.
