## **Home and Community Based Services (HCBS)**

Home and community based services (HCBS) provide the opportunity for people with IDD to receive services in their own home or the community rather than institutions, like a hospital or nursing home, through the state Medicaid program. HCBS targets different groups, such as older adults, people with IDD, physical disabilities, or mental health and substance use disorders. The NJ Division of Developmental Disabilities (DDD) administers two Medicaid waiver programs, the Supports Program and Community Care Program (CCP). Through enrollment in one of these programs, individuals may receive HCBS based on their assessed needs and individualized budget.
