Managed Long Term Services and Supports (MLTSS)

MLTSS is a Medicaid waiver program that offers the delivery of long-term services and supports through the NJ FamilyCare managed care program. MLTSS is designed to expand home and community-based services, promote community inclusion, and ensure quality and efficiency. MLTSS creates access to private duty nursing (PDN) in the community for children who are not otherwise eligible for NJ FamilyCare due to income, but require a skilled level of care. It also provides comprehensive support services, including PDN, to adults with disabilities who meet a clinical level of care and financial eligibility requirements. Administered through their NJ FamilyCare MCO, MLTSS is designed to coordinate individually based support services to allow individuals to remain living in the community. Note that a person with IDD cannot simultaneously be enrolled on MLTSS and the DDD Supports Program or Community Care Program.
