Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP)

The Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) covers low income children through NJ FamilyCare. The goal of "Cover All Kids" is to ensure that every child in New Jersey has access to health insurance. Many children with IDD have access to healthcare through a parent's employer-based, group health insurance plan, but some children with IDD may also qualify for CHIP if the household has lower income. If a child with IDD does not have other health insurance, they may qualify for CHIP under a higher household income limit, up to 355% of the federal poverty level (\$7,884/month for a household of 3 people).
