## NJ FamilyCare

NJ FamilyCare is the federal and state funded health insurance program created to help qualified New Jersey residents of any age access affordable health insurance. **NJ FamilyCare is more commonly known as Medicaid**, but NJ FamilyCare is the provided name for New Jersey's Medicaid program! Each state has a unique name for its Medicaid program, so know that any time you hear "NJ FamilyCare" this is referring to New Jersey's Medicaid program. A person with an intellectual or developmental disability (IDD) who wants to receive services and support through the Division of Developmental Disabilities (DDD), usually at age 21, must be eligible for Medicaid, through NJ FamilyCare!
