SERVICES TO ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUALS WHO

WANT TO PURSUE POST-SECONDARY

EDUCATION OR TRAINING AS PART OF A

PLAN TO ACHIEVE AN EMPLOYMENT

GOAL.

Any college training or counseling provided must be tied to a specific vocational goal outlined in an Individualized Plan for Employment (IPE), which is developed jointly by the individual and a DVRS counselor.

 SUITABLE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS.

 EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES, INCLUDING

 INFORMATION ON TRAINING PROGRAMS,

 TECHNICAL SCHOOLS, AND TWO- OR FOUR
 YEAR COLLEGE DEGREES.
- FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR "COST

 SERVICES" SUCH AS TUITION, FEES, BOOKS,

 AND SUPPLIES, PENDING A FINANCIAL

 NEEDS ASSESSMENT.
