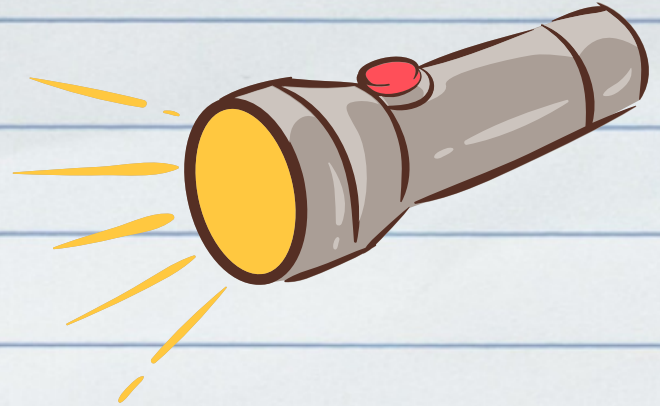


SAFETY KIT



A BASIC EMERGENCY SUPPLY KIT COULD INCLUDE

- Water- One Gallon Per Person A Day
- Food- At Least A Several Day Supply of Non-Perishable Foods
- Flashlight
- First Aid Kit
- Extra Batteries
- Whistle (to signal for help)
- Cell Phone with Charger
- Wrench or Pliers (to turn off utilities)



A BASIC EMERGENCY SUPPLY KIT COULD INCLUDE CONTINUED

- Soap, Sanitizer, Disinfecting Wipes
- Prescription Medications
- Infant Formula, Bottles, Diapers
- Sleeping Bag or Warm Blanket Per Person
- Change of Clothes
- Matches in Waterproof Container
- Books, Games, Puzzles for Children
- Important Family Documents



MAINTAINING YOUR KIT

- Keep canned food in a cool, dry place.
- Store boxed food in tightly closed plastic or metal containers.
- Replace expired items as needed.
- Re-think your needs every year and update your kit as your family's needs change.
- Home: Keep this kit in a designated place and have it ready in case you have to leave your home quickly. Make sure all family members know where the kit is kept.
