exceeds 10% of the family's income that year,
plus 15% of any income over \$100,000,

Who is Eligible for the Fund?

- *The child must have been 21 years or younger when the medical expenses were incurred.*
- *The family must have lived in New Jersey for 3 months immediately prior to the date of application.*
- *The Fund will only reimburse incurred medical expenses that are not covered by any other source.*

What Expenses are Eligible?

- ***Therapies (physical, occupational, speech, psychotherapy, and more)***
- ***Addictions/mental health services***
- ***Acute or specialized hospital care, both in and outpatient***
- ***Physician care in all settings***
- ***Medical equipment or disposable medical supplies***
- ***Pharmaceuticals***
- ***Medically related home modifications and medical transportation***
- ***Home health care***
- ***Modified Vehicles***
