## Medical Assistance Advisory Council (MAAC)

The Medical Assistance Advisory Council ("MAAC") was established through federal law and state statute. The MAAC's main objective is to advise the Assistant Commissioner of the Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services (DMAHS), who oversees NJ FamilyCare/Medicaid, in matters of medical care and health services for Medicaid members while encouraging communication with the public. The MAAC holds quarterly meetings, from 10:00am - 12:00pm, via Zoom. The MAAC is also accepting applications for the Medicaid Advisory Committee (MAC) and the Beneficiary Advisory Council (BAC). ## 1. Medicaid Advisory Committee (MAC):

Open to all members of community, including:

- State or local consumer advocacy groups or community-based organizations that represent or provide services to Medicaid members
- Clinical providers or administrators
- Participating Managed Care Organization (MCOs) or health plan association

## 2. Beneficiary Advisory Council (BAC) Members:

Open to:

- Current or former NJ Medicaid members; or
- Individuals with direct experience supporting Medicaid members (family members, paid or unpaid caregivers)
