# Our Process Ensures Patient Safety

**Average Appointment Lead Time Is Typically 3-4 Weeks  
Once Clearances Are Completed**

1. Initial screening and consultation visit
2. Preoperative medical clearances
3. Clinical appointment and treatment
4. Postoperative follow up
5. Recall appointment determination

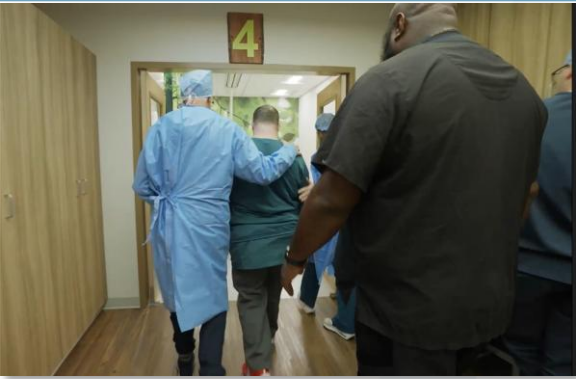
