Medicaid Benefit Plans for Eligible Applicants

NJ FamilyCare has five main benefit plan types for people who are approved for Medicaid services: Plan A, Plan B, Plan C, Plan D, and Plan ABP (Alternative Benefit Plan). A person is assigned to one of these plans based on their age and income, but all five of these plans provide full, comprehensive Medicaid coverage. The main differences between these plans are the copayments ("co-pays"), ranging from \$0-35, and that only Plan A and Plan ABP provide coverage under fee-for-service (FFS) Medicaid until a person is enrolled in a health plan. Someone under Plan A or Plan ABP can also request up to 3 months of retroactive coverage, if considered eligible during that time, but the retroactive coverage only pays for services from FFS Medicaid providers.

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
