NJ Care Special Medicaid Programs

An ABD Medicaid program that is available to individuals with disabilities that have monthly income below 100% of the federal poverty level (\$1,305/month in 2025), and resources/assets under \$4,000, excluding funds in an ABL account or Special Needs Trust. It is also sometimes referred to as “County Medicaid” or “Community Medicaid.” There is only one type of ABD application, but when a person submits an ABD application, they are evaluated for potential eligibility through every ABD program. If an individual is not receiving Supplemental Security Income (SSI) or is not able to financially qualify for SSI, they may instead qualify for NJ Care Special Medicaid.
