Renewing NJ FamilyCare Medicaid Coverage

If a person applied to Medicaid by submitting an online or paper Aged, Blind, Disabled (ABD) application, and is not enrolled on Medicaid through their Supplemental Security Income (SSI) eligibility, they must complete an annual renewal application. Medical enrollees should expect to renew their coverage once a year. Ensure that NJ FamilyCare and the County Board of Social Services have your correct address and contact information. A person receives mail from the State of New Jersey or their County Board of Social Services notifying them of their time of year to renew. Most people who have a managed care organization (MCO), also known as an HMO or a health plan, will also get a postcard from their plan. This means that their renewal packet is coming that month, and they should look for mail. Always promptly return the renewal and any other requested information! Doing so protects against a person being potentially terminated from Medicaid for not returning requested documents or their renewal in a timely manner.
