

# Common Accommodations for Dyslexia

Repeat oral instructions,  
check for understanding

Highlight or underline significant  
words

Pre-teach new vocabulary and  
important concepts before a  
lesson

Provide reading materials with  
large print, increased spacing,  
and fewer items per page

Provide a peer note taker or  
scribe for written assignments

Use an audio recording device  
to record directions, stories,  
and specific lessons

# Common Accommodations for Dyslexia Cont.

**Simplify written directions**

**Extend the allotted time for the student to complete assignments and assessments**

**Incorporate pictures into directions, daily schedules, and vocabulary words as a visual aid**

**Adjust the reading levels of books, worksheets, and other materials**

**Block out extraneous stimuli from worksheets or reading materials**
