County Boards of Social Services

Each county in New Jersey has a Board of Social Services (BoSS), also known as county welfare offices or County Social Service Agencies (CSSAs). These agencies offer assistance with many different services and programs, including the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) and Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF). These county offices also help families with NJ FamilyCare and process Medicaid applications. While applicants are usually encouraged to apply online, someone can submit a paper Aged, Blind, Disabled (ABD) NJ FamilyCare Medicaid application to their local county welfare office as well.
