Submitting a Paper ABD Application

While the "regular" NJ FamilyCare Medicaid application can only be filled out online, a person has the option of submitting an ABD application online, by mail, or dropping it off in person at your local County Board of Social Services or County Welfare office. Once you complete the ABD application, along with providing supporting documentation, you can opt to mail the application to your local county social services office. It is highly recommended to mail your application with a certified mail receipt so that you can track the application and receive proof of receipt. You also have the option of hand delivering your application to the office in person. If you hand deliver the application to an employee at your local county office, it may be helpful to ask for their information, should you need to contact them in the future regarding your application.
